

Cherry Hill FC U12 Girls Summer Select Program

About the Program

The program is developed to bring together committed soccer players who are interested in competing in various high-level soccer matches throughout the late Spring and Summer. It is designed to provide players with exceptional tactical and technical training while still retaining the player's enjoyment of the game.

Players will be selected on merit and not Club or League affiliation. Players will experience a chance to play alongside like-minded players who are dedicated to the sport of soccer.

This is a summer program only. Players will be carded thru US Club soccer and this carding does not conflict with any players carded through NJYS. All players carded with US Club during the summer are released from their cards on August 1st, 2010.

Practices will begin in mid-May (Week 10 of SJGSL games). Players will be expected to honor their commitments to their Club spring season teams first.

Players will receive:

- 4 Tournaments
- 2 Complete Uniform Sets (Jersey w/name on back, shorts, socks)
- 2 Practice T-shirts
- Up to 16 practice sessions conducted by a professional trainer
- 3 Goalie Training sessions

Age Groups

This fact sheet pertains to the U12 Girls program only. Exceptional U11 players will be considered, but no players below U11 are permitted to tryout.

U12 - (Born Between Aug 1997 and July 1998)

Cost

The cost for the entire program is \$400. There will be no fee to participate in the tryout. \$225 will be due at a "Meet the Team" function in March. The remainder is due by the first practice. All training, tournament, and uniform fees are included in the cost of the program. The players can be expected to incur other personal and family travel expenses, particularly for any overnight tournaments.

Training

Practice sessions will begin on or about May 12, 2010 (the final scheduled week of the SJGSL). Practices will be held twice a week (likely Wednesday Nights and Saturday Mornings), weather permitting.

The CHFC U12 Girls Summer Select team will utilize two exceptional long-time trainers to conduct the practices. The practices will be structured and coordinated, but each trainer will add his own individual elements to the training experience. The trainers are scheduled to be Tony Lindgren, a former professional player from England and Mario Vega, a former professional player from Spain.

Practices are scheduled to be 90 minutes and held either at the Decou fields in Cherry Hill or another local field that is within 5 minutes of a Rt. 295 Exit in the Cherry Hill/Voorhees area.

Tryouts

All players must attend the tryout at Cherry Hill's Decou fields (Cropwell & Evesham Rd, Cherry Hill, NJ 08003)

Date: Sunday February 28, 2010, 3-5 PM (registration starts at 2:30 pm).

Rain date: Sunday March 7, 5-7 PM (registration at 4:30).

2010 Player Applications are required and will be accepted via email or at the registration table the day of tryouts. Applications submitted via e-mail should be sent to chfcsummersoccer@gmail.com. Application forms as well as directions to Decou fields can be found on cherryhillfcsoccer.com website or by e-mail request.

On a showing of exceptional circumstances, a player may be permitted to tryout at an alternate location should they not be able to make the tryout date.

Selections will be made from the trainer controlled tryout. The selections will be announced as soon as practical and we expect to extend invitations within a few weeks of the tryouts.
